A program featuring a song by Black Sabbath?! After you pick yourself up off the floor, give it a chance. This number presents an incredible amount of rock-solid spiritual truth for our discussion. You may say, "I won't consider anything coming from a group like that!". But just consider what the Apostle Paul said –

"...The important thing is that in every way, whether from false motives or true, Christ is preached..." (Philippians 1:18, NIV).

That is not to suggest that the songwriter penned these lyrics with false motives (Indeed, he alludes to a personal conversion experience in the 2<sup>nd</sup> stanza), but to highlight that God will honor His word, however it goes forward... and it does not return void!

# The Song 1,2

- Featured on Black Sabbath's 3rd studio album, Master of Reality, released in '71
- Focuses entirely on Christian themes an astounding anomaly in the group's repertoire, since most Black Sabbath songs feature dark, gloomy lyrics

## The Group – Black Sabbath <sup>1,3</sup>

- Formed in Birmingham, England, in 1968 as Earth Blues Company
- Changed name to Black Sabbath after a song inspired by an experience of the group's bassist, Terry Butler, who dabbled in the "black arts"
  - He observed "a figure from the dark side at the foot of his bed one night"
  - Song's title came from a Boris Karloff film of the same name
- Noted for riff-based songs, extreme volume, and dark, demonic subject matter
- Credited with creating "heavy metal" -- a new genre in the world of rock music
- Members characterize themselves as a "heavy underground" band
- Became eligible for Rock and Roll Hall of Fame '95; inducted in '06
- Recorded their most popular album, *Paranoid*, in just a few days
  - o Included "Iron Man" and "Paranoid", for which the group is best known
- Ozzy Osbourne left in '78; group continued, but never equaled prior successes

### Final Thoughts...

If you listen to Christian rock music today, you may readily conclude that this Black Sabbath number was about 35+ years ahead of its time. Amid all the gloom, doom and dark themes for which this group is known shines the message in "After Forever". It continues to be aired on radio, and performed for crowds that desperately need to hear its message and to know Jesus Christ. Accept Him today – live for Him – and don't be ashamed!

Jesus said -- "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will save it. What good is it for a man to gain the whole world, and yet lose or forfeit his very self? If anyone is ashamed of me and my words, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes in his glory and in the glory of the Father and of the holy angels."
