## Program 1 – "Love Is The Answer" © 1977 Todd Rundgren

England Dan and John Ford Coley took this cover of Utopia's 1977 inspirational hit to #10 on the U.S. pop charts, and #1 in the Adult Contemporary rankings in 1979.<sup>1</sup> Written by legendary performer, songwriter and producer Todd Rundgren, "Love Is The Answer" develops, with buoyant optimism, several principles consistent with Scripture and the Christian life. Christian artists sometimes alter secular song lyrics for doctrinal purposes, but it appears unnecessary for this number. For example, Christian artist Cindy Morgan's rendition reflects Rundgren's lyrics, word-for-word. "Love Is The Answer", when considered in the context of God's love, is sound advice indeed.

### **Final Thoughts:**

In what some call His “Sermon on the Plain”, Jesus described a love that goes against the grain -- well beyond what we do instinctively. He said...

*“If you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? Even 'sinners' love those who love them. And if you do good to those who are good to you, what credit is that to you? Even 'sinners' do that. And if you lend to those from whom you expect repayment, what credit is that to you? Even 'sinners' lend to 'sinners,' expecting to be repaid in full.” – Luke 6:32-34, NIV*

He goes on to explain that we should love and help others regardless of whether they reciprocate...

*“But love your enemies, do good to them, and lend to them without expecting to get anything back. Then your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High, because he is kind to the ungrateful and wicked.” – Luke 6:35*

That's a supernatural love – the kind that Jesus, the Light of the world, shines on us!
