I. Last Meal Together

1. Before Jesus' death
2. Before Judas' sin and death
3. Many times had eaten together
 - A. As a group
 - B. With multitude
 - C. At Mary and Martha's house

II. Last Service Together

1. Jesus taught of:
 - A. Humility and service
 - B. Death
 - C. Resurrection
 - D. Eternal life – kingdom to come
 - E. Spiritual partaking of His body and blood
2. Jesus warned of...
 - A. Betrayal – urged Judas to decide course
 - B. Peter's backsliding
3. Jesus and disciples sang a hymn
4. Many times they had worshipped together
 - A. On the mountain
 - B. By the sea
 - C. In the synagogue

III. Last Evening For Little Church To Be Together

1. Judas would leave, sin, and die
2. Other disciples would run away
